- *Laptops are to be locked away after sessions. Students sign laptops in and out. Purpose College will not take any responsibility for loss or damage.*
- *No gadgets, cell phones, tablets, earphones or any other devices may be taken to the centre. These will be taken on arrival.*
- *Silence should prevail at all times. No noise will be tolerated. This requirement will not be repeated. Talking and chatting during sessions will result in consequences. This is NOT negotiable.*
- *Bathroom use will be in accordance with your Healing Wings rules.*
- *Students are not allowed to climb/stand/sit on desks or hang against walls or furniture. A respectful and decent posture and behaviour is expected and any less will not be accepted*
- *Damaging property will be for the accountholders account. Each case will be investigated individually and your privilege to be attending our centre will be withdrawn in case a pattern of destructive behaviour is revealed.*
- *Premises ought to be kept clean at all times. No one will be cleaning after you. It is your responsibility.*
- *No fighting, running or bullying will be tolerated. This includes verbal and physical fighting.*
